

**Annual Report In Compliance of Order of Hon'ble
National Green Tribunal Passed In OA No. 360/2015,
National Green Tribunal Vs. Virendra Singh (State Of
Gujrat) In Connection With Illegal Sand Mining**

INTRODUCTION:

Hon'ble National Green Tribunal dealing with the matter of OA No. 360/2015, National Green Tribunal Bar Association vs Virendra Singh. Several cases have been filed regarding remedial action against illegal sand mining in the States of Gujarat, Karnataka, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Odisha, Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh. Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed in Deepak Kumar Vs State of Haryana & Ors. (2012) 4 SCC 629 that leases of minor minerals including their renewal, even for an area of less than 5 hectares be granted only after environmental clearance from MOEF&CC. The direction was held to be necessary in view of degradation of environment on account of illegal and unrestricted upstream, instream and flood plain sand mining activities. As per the observation by Hon'ble Supreme Court, the absence of regulation of such mining was not justified as it was a threat to bio-diversity, could destroy riverine vegetation, cause erosion, pollute water sources, badly affect riparian ecology, damage ecosystem of rivers, safety of bridges, cause weakening of riverbeds, destruction of natural habitats of organisms living on the riverbeds, affect fish breeding and migration, spell disaster for the conservation of bird species and increase saline water in the rivers. These mining activities have direct impact on the physical habitat characteristics of the rivers (i.e. bed elevation, substrate composition and stability, in-stream roughness of elements, depth, velocity, turbidity, sediment transport, stream discharge and temperature). Thus, lack of proper management and planning disturbs marine ecosystem and upsets the ability of natural marine processes to replenish the sand.

Tripura State lies in the eastern part of India, bordered by Bangladesh to the west, south and north, by Assam to the north-east, and by Mizoram to the east. It is bounded by latitudes 22° 56'N and 24° 32'N, and longitudes 91°10'E and 92°21'E. It has an area of 10,477 sq. km., and is a rugged and geologically a younger terrain. It has a link with Assam and rest of the country through the adjoining Cachar district, lying to the north-east.

Physiography Geomorphology

The topography is immature. The major geomorphic elements observed in the area are both structural and topographic 'highs' and 'depressions', 'flats' and 'slopes', sculptured on the topographic surface in a linear and areal fashion. In Tripura the topographic highs and lows are in accordance with the normal first order structural elements. The state is dissected by a number of broad and long valleys, viz., Agartala-Udaipur-Sabrum, Khowai-Telimura-Amarpur-Silachari, Kamalpur-Ambasa-Candachara, Kailashar-Kumarghat, Dharmanagar-Panisagar, etc. located between the N-S trending parallel to sub-parallel antiformal hill ranges (topographic highs), such as the Baramura-Deotamura Ranges, the Atharamura Ranges, the Langtarai Ranges, the Shakan Ranges, and the anticlinal ranges. There are a few disconnected open and shallow anticlinal ridges, viz. Gazalia-Mamunbhagna anticline, Sonamura anticline, Agartala dome, etc. Besides, small-scale elements like the spurs, keels, and the moderate gorges are the other geomorphic elements formed.

Drainage

Generally, the valleys are broad and flat with low to moderate Bed Relief Index (BRI), which are separated from the adjacent highs with domes and conical peaks. Some of the peaks of the hills are also flat. The R. L. differences between the elevations of the peaks and valleys increases eastwards constantly. The general altitude of the state varies between 16 m to 600 m above m.s.l. The drainage patterns are of 'dendritic', 'parallel' to 'sub-parallel' and 'rectangular' types. The stream channel patterns lie mainly within the 'piedmont', 'straight' and 'meandering' reaches. The 'braided reach' is, however, not noticed along the course of the stream channels. The drainage flows down along north by the Khowai, Dhalai, Manu, Juri and Langai Rivers ; west by the Gumti River and southwest by the Fenny and Muhari Rivers.

Climate and Rainfall

The climate is generally hot and humid, the average maximum temperature being 35°C and the average minimum 10.5°C. The state has a fairly good annual rainfall (around 230 cm. per annum). The monsoon generally starts in the middle of April and continues up to September. Heavy rainfall causes severe floods almost every year, disconnecting the state to the rest of the country.

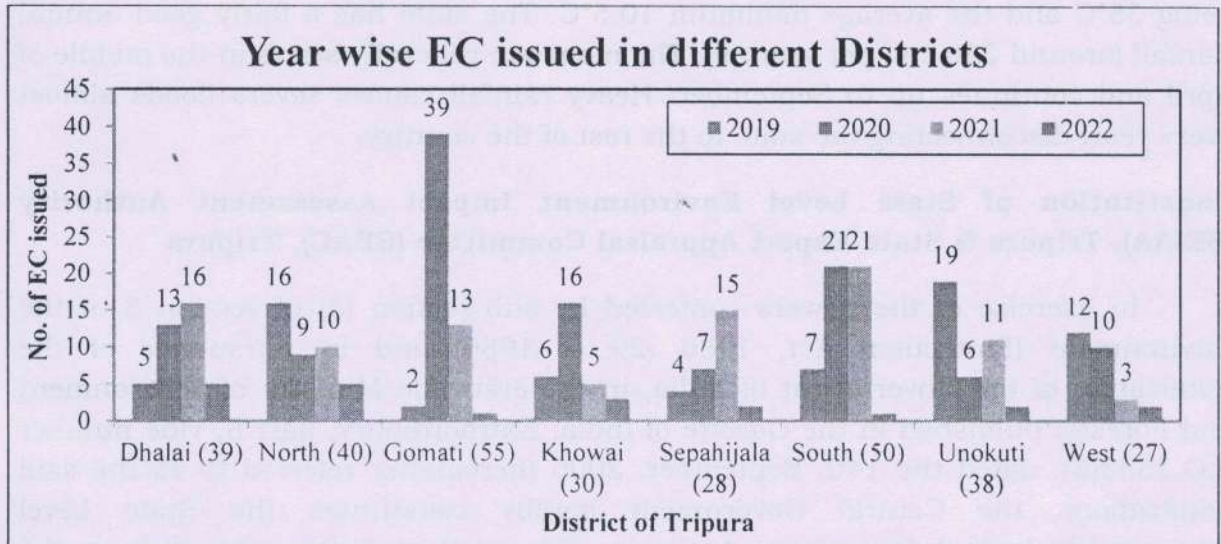

The Gazette Notification No.S.O.1198(E) dated 17/03/2022 is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

The first SEIAA & SEAC, Tripura was constituted in the year 2014. Further the same was reconstituted in the year 2018 and 2022. Till date, 307 Nos. of Environmental Clearance has been issued for sand mining in the State. Year wise issuance of Environmental Clearance for sand mining is given below:

The details of EC issued are given in **Annexure-II**.

Earlier prospective Project Proponent used to submit their application offline i.e., directly to SEIAA-Tripura and further the same was forwarded to SEAC Tripura for appraisal. Now MoEF&CC, Govt. of India launched Parivesh Portal (parivesh.nic.in) where prospective Project Proponent submit application through online only which leads to speedy issuance of Environmental Clearance. In Tripura, it is mandatory to submit application form through online only. No offline applications are entertained by the SEIAA-Tripura. A copy of the advertisement published in the local newspaper in this regard is enclosed at **Annexure-III**.

- the Chairman and Members of the Authority, Tripura and SEAC, Tripura shall not undertake any consultation or associate with preparation of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Environment Management Plan for a project, which is to be appraised by the Authority, Tripura and SEAC, Tripura during their tenure; and
- where in the preceding five years, the Chairman or any of the Members of the Authority, Tripura and SEAC, Tripura have provided consultancy service or conducted EIA study for any project proponent, in that case he shall recuse himself from the meeting of the Authority, Tripura and SEAC, Tripura in the process of appraisal of any project being proposed by such proponent.

10. The Government of Tripura shall notify an agency to act as Secretariat for the Authority, Tripura and SEAC, Tripura and the Secretariat shall provide all financial and logistic support including accommodation, transportation and such other facility in respect of all his statutory functions.

11. The sitting fee, travelling allowance and dearness allowance to the Chairman and Members of the Authority, Tripura and SEAC, Tripura shall be paid in accordance with the rules of the Government of Tripura.

8. The State Level Expert Appraisal Committee, Tripura shall function on the principle of collective responsibility and the Chairman shall endeavor to reach a consensus in each case, and if consensus cannot be reached, the views of the majority shall prevail.

9. The Government of Tripura shall notify an agency to act as Secretariat for the Authority, Tripura and the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee, Tripura, and shall provide all financial and logistic support including accommodation, transportation and such other facilities in respect of all their statutory functions.

10. The sitting fee, travelling allowance and dearness allowance to the Chairman and members of the Authority, Tripura and the Chairman and members of the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee, Tripura shall be paid in accordance with the relevant rules of the Government of Tripura.



Complex, Agartala, West Tripura under the Chairmanship of Dr. Jaharlal Saha, SEIAA, Tripura.

The following issues were discussed in the said Meeting.

1. Issuance of Environment Clearance (ECs) Certificate of 21 nos. Sand Mine Unit.

Total 21 no. approved mining plans of Sand Mining Units have been received offline from Forest Department, Govt. of Tripura. The approved mining plans (pending) have been placed before the joint Meeting for consideration.

On scrutiny of the approved Mining Plans and other relevant documents submitted by the project proponents, the Committee has found the applications in order and approved

the applications for issuance of environmental Clearance Certificate subject to various terms and conditions for a period of 5(five) Years.

2. Decision for the pending applications of Parivesh Portal which are submitted without obtaining approval from Forest Department.

Vide EIA Notification No.S.O.141(E) of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, New Delhi dated 15th January 2016 (Amendment of EIA Notification, 2006), the Project Proponent dealing with Minor Minerals should submit their application which includes Form-1M, PFR along with approved Mining Plan from Forest Department, govt. of Tripura for consideration.

As on 25/03/2022, total 37 nos. applications along with mining plans of sand and brick mining units have been submitted in Parivesh Portal (parivesh.nic.in). During examination, it has been observed that the mining plans are not duly approved by the Forest Department, Govt. of Tripura.

After prolong discussions, both the Committee has resolved that the mining plans that have been received through Parivesh Portal without prior approval of the Forests Department will be treated as incomplete and may not be taken for further consideration.

It has been decided that, at first the Project proponent of sand mining and brick kiln units will submit Mining Plan in Forest Department for obtaining approval. After obtained approved Mining Plan from Forest Department, Proponent will submit Form-1M, PFR along with approved Mining Plan in Parivesh Portal (parivesh.nic.in) for consideration and issuance of EC. In this regard, an advertisement may be published in 2 (two) local Vernacular Newspapers for wider circulation and dissemination. Also, it has been decided by the joint committee to inform Forest Department, Govt. of Tripura in this regard.



The competent authority SEIAA, Tripura constituted a committee in compliance of the Order dated 26.02.2021 of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principle Bench, New Delhi in O.A No. 360 of 2015, for inspection and to check the compliance of EC conditions. To expedite the inspection process the joint committee has decided to request Tripura State Pollution Control Board to hire a vehicle as on when required. The vehicle will also mitigate the crisis and will provide transportation support to the Chairman & all Members SEIAA/SEAC secretariats.



The 1st Meeting of the Committee constituted by Notification No. 8(25)/TSPCB/SEAC/2019/GNT/720-34 dated 23/6/21 was held on 30/3/2022 at 3.30 PM in the Conference Hall of Tripura State Pollution Control Board, P.N. Complex, Agartala, West Tripura under the Chairmanship of Dr. Jaharlal Saha, SEIAA, Tripura.

The following issues were discussed in the said Meeting:

1. An Advertisement may be published in the daily local Newspaper for submission of half yearly Compliance Report of Sand and Brick Mining units of the Tripura State.

As on 30/3/2022, a total no. of 286 Sand Mining units and 278 Brick earth mining units has obtained Environmental Clearance Certificate from SEIAA, Tripura. In accordance with Terms & Condition laid down in EC certificate it is mandatory for Sand and brick earth mining units to submit half yearly compliance report in hard copy and soft copy to the Office of SEIAA/SEAC Secretariat and Tripura State Pollution Control Board on 1st June & 1st December of each Calendar year. It has been observed that the existing mining units have not submitted EC compliance report in the stipulated time. The matter has been discussed thoroughly in the said meeting. It has been decided that for wider circulation of compliance of EC terms & conditions, we may publish a notice in a category -A vernacular local newspaper for compulsory submission of half yearly compliance report within 7 days from the date of publishing of the notice.

2. Inspection/visit may be carried out from 3rd April, 2022 in all existing Sand mining units in compliance of the Order dated 26.02.2021 of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal ; Principle Bench, New Delhi in O.A No. 360 of 2015.

The matter has been placed before the committee. It has been decided that to check/assessment of damage of the environment due to sand mining activity, inspection may be carried out at least 3 (thrice) for each lease, i.e. after expiry of 25% of the lease period and then after 50 % of the lease period and finally 6 months before expiry of the lease period in sand mining units in compliance of the Order dated 26.02.2021 of Hon'ble National Green


